11 **III. Report of the Representative Registration Committee**

12 Eligible to vote were 12 Officers and Directors, 40 Delegates and 3 alternates.

14 **IV. Approval/Corrections of Previous Meeting Minutes**—Wanda Murray made a motion to accept the  
15 minutes and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Bonnie Keeney. Vote taken, motion carried.

17 **V. Reports of Officers**—

18 a) Debbie Kenderdine---Had many “thank yous” to go around. To Wanda Murray for all her work on the  
19 Ways & Means with the souvenir stands. To Bill & Bonnie Keeney and Wanda Murray for taking over the  
20 Championships Tournament. To Dave Reagle for representing us as a delegate to the national meeting.

21 b) Jay Daryman---Ditto on the thank you’s to everyone. To Butler County for doing a great job with the  
22 Pepsi State Tournament. To York/Adams County Association for their great job with the State  
23 Championships.

24 Jay’s focus will be cut and dry the rest of the meeting. He wants the delegates to contact him with any ideas.

26 **VI. Committee Reports and Actions--**

28 a) Audit----- Mike Frey gave a report and found nothing out of order.

30 b) Budget and Finance – Jay asked the delegates to review the financial statements. He explained the un-  
31 assigned funds. He also explained the general account and how the report shows our different accounts.  
32 Jay then went through the budget report. He explained how HQ dictated the state dues for this year. He told  
33 the delegates about the decline in membership in Pennsylvania.

35 c) Legislative

36 Due to actions by the USBC National Board of Directors, our state dues will change from the current \$.25 per  
37 member to \$.50 per member. The appropriate sections will be changed after conclusion of the USBC  
38 Convention and final approval of all changes within the USBC Youth Program.

39 All associations must now file a Form 990. This is a requirement.

40 There are no official proposed legislative changes to our bylaws.

42 d) Tournaments

44 State Pepsi Tournament

45 \$57,400 was given out in scholarships this year.

46 One rule change for 2010 will be the ratio from 1:8 to 1:5 advancing from the league level to the district level  
47 tournament.

48 League Level Pepsi kits can be pulled from bowl.com or from the state web-site. Jay will e-mail everyone  
49 when it is available.

50 The 2010 Pepsi State Tournament will be held in Allentown at Parkway Lanes and the Hampton Lanes.

51 Debbie talked about the results of a survey that were taken during the Pepsi State Tournament pertaining to  
52 the Dress Code. The results indicated just a few comments about wearing shorts. But overall nothing for the

## 55 Championships Tournament 2009

58 2010 State Championships tournament will be held in Eire during the last 3 weekends in April.

59 A January 1, 2010 average will be used instead of the February 1<sup>st</sup> average.

61 Based on info received at the summit from last year, Jay explained why tournament was moved to April
